In response to your request for an update on the implementation of Recommendations R5 of your report titled, "Marin's Human Sex Trafficking Challenge: It's Happening In Our Backyard". I apologize for the delay as the request was sent to a non-frequented P.O. Box.

Recommendation R5: Marin County Fire Departments should ensure that all EMS personnel are trained in recognizing human trafficking and how to report and incorporate this in their annual training.

SMEMPS agencies (Tiburon Fire District, Southern Marin Fire Protection District, Mill Valley Fire Department and Marin County Fire Department) and, to the best of our knowledge, all other Marin County Fire Chiefs member agencies, have received training in the recognition and reporting of human trafficking. S MEMPS training occurred September 19th-28th, 2016. As part of our continuing education program, all member agencies will conduct refresher training each June as part of our policy and procedure update.
