Pursuant to the Grand Jury's letter of November 29, 2016 requesting the timeline for implementation of Recommendations 1-3, below is Dixie School District's response.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- R1. Each school in the district should review its policies and procedures to ensure full compliance with the requirements of Seth's Law.
Response:
Recommendation R1 has been implemented.
- R2. Each school in the district should review its policies and procedures to ensure that complainants are protected from retaliation, and that their identity remains confidential.
Response:
Recommendation R2 has been implemented.
- R3. Each school in the district should adequately publicize its anti-bullying policies and procedures through its website, including a direct link on the website's homepage to the information (not simply linking to a lengthy student handbook, but directly to the anti-bullying policy and procedures themselves).
