2015-16 Web Transparency Report Card: Response to Findings and Recommendations Re:

The Belvedere Tiburon Library Agency has updated the information on its website to provide transparency as listed and described in the report dated March, 2016.

The following changes and additions have been made:

A. There had been a link to the citizens appointed to the Belvedere Tiburon Library. Agency members are volunteer and therefore unpaid. We included a link to the elected officials who make the appointments to the Agency.

B. There had been a link to the salaries for individual staff. That has been updated to include a link to the State Controller's website that lists overall compensation, including salaries and benefits, which complies with R3 recommendations.

C. There had been a link to the Agency's funding reserves policy. We have updated the information to also include the Agency's investment policy.

D. Though we have no contracts at this time, a link has been included for contracts. If contracts occur, the link would be activated and the information provided.

E. The agency has always filed the Statement of Facts with the California Secretary of State as per R2 recommendation. We will also file this information with the Marin County Clerk as required by California Code 53051.
