**Response to Recommendation R1**

This recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable. Due to cost to create and maintain a website and a staff consisting of only one employee, MPTA has not established a website and does not presently have any plans to do so.

**Response to Recommendation R2**

The recommendation has been implemented. MPTA mailed an updated Statement of Facts to the Secretary of State and Marin County Clerk on September 8, 2016.

**Response to Recommendation R3**

This recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable. Due to the cost to establish and maintain a website and a staff consisting of only one employee, the Executive Director, MPTA has not established a website. The Executive Director's employment agreement is considered and approved in public session at a noticed meeting of MPTA's Board of Directors. The employment agreement is available to any member of the public who desires to review or receive a copy. MPTA does not compensate the members of its Board of Directors.

MPTA's fiscal agent, currently Tamalpais Union High School District, maintains and reports annual compensation information of the Executive Director.
