This letter explains in detail the Town of Tiburon’s response to the Civil Grand Jury Report dated May 9, 2018. The Report directs the Town to respond to Recommendation 5.

RECOMMENDATIONS and RESPONSES

Recommendation 5. The County of Marin and each City should actively seek developers to create housing for the homelessness within their jurisdictions.

Town’s Response:

This recommendation will not be implemented because it is not warranted or is not reasonable. The Town of Tiburon does not have adequate staff to ‘actively’ seek developers for any housing projects within the Town. However, the Town does strive to make the planning process as simple and transparent as possible, and offers various incentives to housing projects to increase the number of units designated for individuals and families who qualify as low and moderate income.
