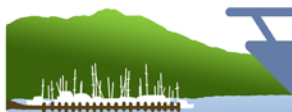
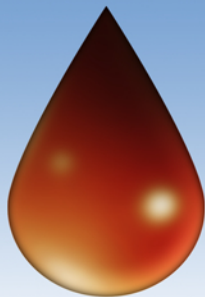

## A CLEAN BAY BEGINS WITH YOU

-  It is illegal to discharge untreated sewage into San Francisco Bay. Discharging any sewage, treated or untreated, into Richardson Bay is illegal. Use shore-side restrooms whenever possible and sewage pump-out facilities for on-board sanitation systems. Call 1-800-CLEANUP for pump-out locations.
-  Recycle used motor oil at no charge! Call 1-800-CLEANUP for a location near you. Some locations may charge a small fee for the filters—ask first! It is illegal to toss used motor oil and filters into the trash.
-  Take oil soaked absorbents, gasoline, paints, solvents, etc., to the free Household Hazardous Waste Facility. Call 485-6806. (Novato residents should call 892-7344.)
-  Report oil and chemical spills to 1(800) OILS911 and 1(800) 424-8802.
