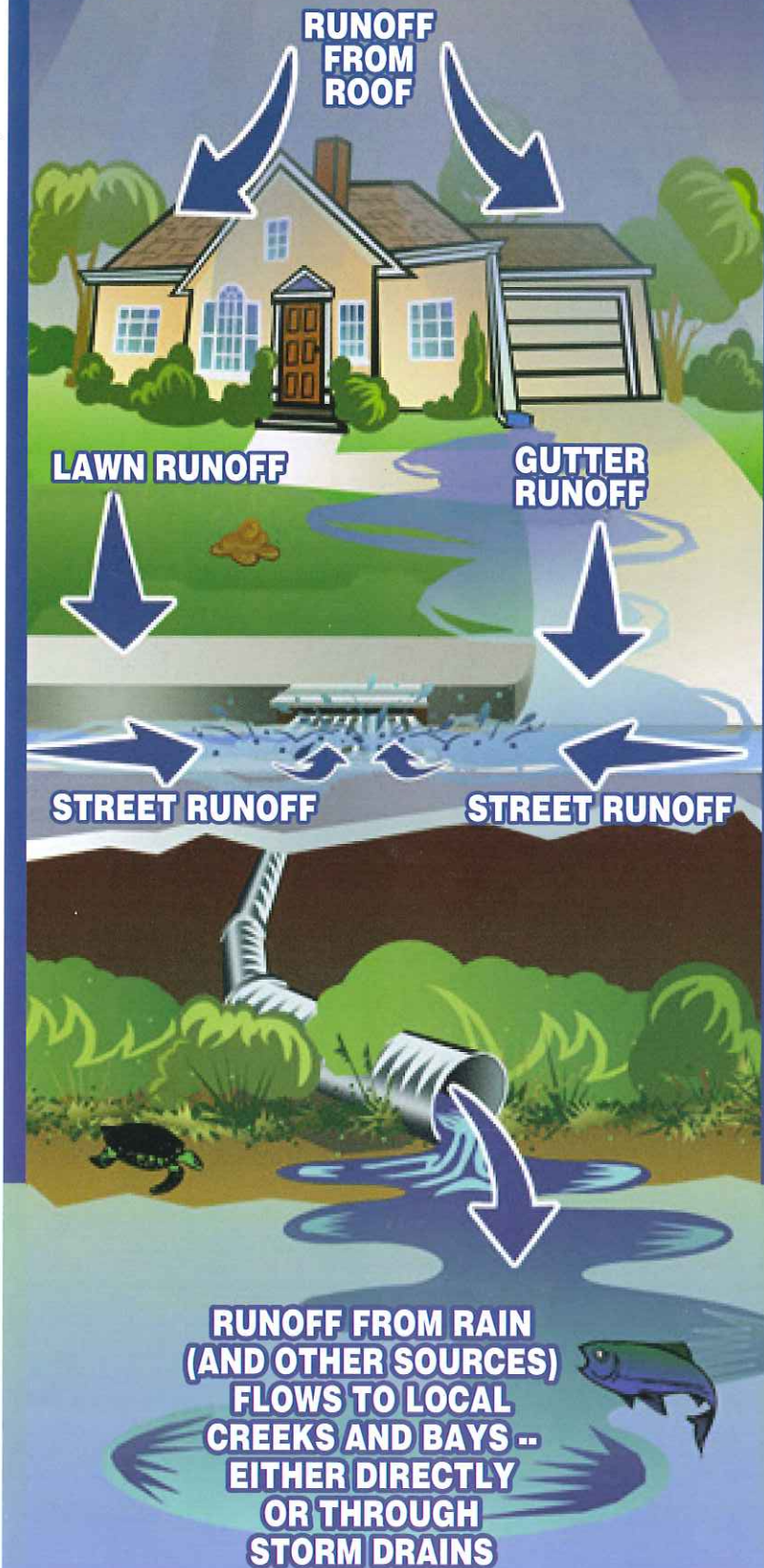
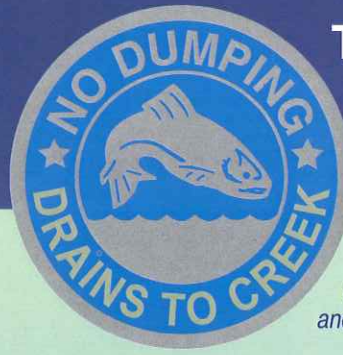


Where Does the Rain Go?





Take Action to Protect Local Creeks!

Pollutants (e.g. trash, oil, pet waste, pesticides) can enter a storm drain as they wash off streets, driveways and parking lots.

- 💧 **Never dump anything down storm drains**
- 💧 **Avoid pesticides if possible - use the least toxic alternative available**
- 💧 **Sweep driveways, sidewalks and gutters - dispose of debris in the trash**
- 💧 **Keep your creekbank free of trash and yard clippings**
- 💧 **Contact MCSTOPPP and your local sanitary district before draining your pool or spa**
- 💧 **Vegetate bare spots with native plants to prevent weeds from growing**
- 💧 **Direct downspouts to landscaped areas, allowing rainwater to soak into the soil**
- 💧 **Take your car to the car wash instead of washing it in the driveway**
- 💧 **Check vehicles for leaks and recycle used motor oil and filters**
- 💧 **Pick up after your pet**
- 💧 **Check your sewer laterals for leaks - call your local sanitary district for information**
