**NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS**

INVITING SEALED PROPOSALS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed Proposals will be received by the **Board of Supervisors, County of Marin, Administration Building, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 329, San Rafael, California 94903**, until **2:30PM on August 29, 2019** for:

**Lagoon Park Irrigation Mainline Replacement Phase II  
Project No. 41CAP18004/18-0401**

**Project Description:** Lagoon Park is a 10-acre community park which is part of the Marin County Civic Center Campus and maintained by Marin County Parks. The existing system and asbestos mainline at Lagoon Park were constructed in the early to mid-1960's and are beyond their design life. This project is the second phase of irrigation mainline replacement. Project scope includes the installation of approximately 1,000 linear feet of new reclaimed PVC irrigation mainline pipe and abandoning the existing asbestos cement mainline; installation and/or connection of laterals; installation of controller for Phase 2 limits as well as irrigation valves and boxes and quick couplers and boxes; wiring and electrical grounding for the new irrigation system; and drip irrigation stubs for mulch areas. The new section will connect to an existing asbestos irrigation mainline.

**Contractor license A, B or C27 is required.**

A pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 AM August 19, 2019. Meet at Lagoon Park restrooms on Civic Center Drive.

2. The Engineer's estimated cost for the accomplishment of this work is \$220,000.
3. The work shall be performed in accordance with official Drawings, Specifications, and other Contract Documents prepared in reference thereto which may be examined at the Department of Public Works, 3501 Civic Center Dr., Room 304, Marin County Civic Center Administration Building, San Rafael, California, and selected Bay Area builder's exchanges and trade publications.
4. Copies of the Project Drawings, Specifications and other Bid Documents may be acquired by prospective Bidders at The Marin County Department of Public Works upon payment of \$50.00 per set (cash, or check made payable to the County of Marin) to cover the cost of printing and processing, which payment is NON-REFUNDABLE, and the documents need not be returned. There will be a \$30.00 service fee for returned checks. **Electronic Plans and Specs are complimentary and can be obtained by calling Marin County DPW at (415) 473-2503 or emailing your request to [bids@marincounty.org](mailto:bids@marincounty.org).** Mailed requests should be addressed to the Marin County Department of Public Works, County of Marin, Attention: Capital Projects Division, P.O. 5. For detailed information regarding the scope of the Project, Bidders may contact the Capital Projects Division of the Marin County Department of Public Works; telephone number (415) 473-6528.
6. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed in a bid proposal, subject to the requirements of Section 4104 of the Public Contract Code or engage in the performance of any contract for public work, as defined in this chapter, unless currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code. It is not a violation of this section for an unregistered contractor to submit a bid that is authorized by Section 7029.1 of the Business and Professions Code or by Section 10164 or 20103.5 of the Public Contract Code, provided the contractor is registered to perform public work pursuant to Section 1725.5 of the Labor Code at the time the contract is awarded. This project is subject to compliance monitoring by the Department of Industrial Relations.
7. All Bids must be submitted on the Proposal Form bound in the Project Manual, or a copy thereof, and must be accompanied with a Proposal Guaranty of at least 10% of the amount of the Base bid.
8. Sealed Proposals will be received until the time and in the place stated above, and shortly thereafter will be **publicly opened and read aloud in Room 304**, Administration Building, Marin County Civic Center.
9. The award of the Contract, if it be awarded, will be to the lowest responsible Bidder whose Proposal complies with the prescribed requirements, and will be made within thirty (30) calendar days after the bid opening. The Board of Supervisors reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any irregularity in any bid received.
10. Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rates for Marin County where the work is to be done have been determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. These wages are set forth in the General Prevailing Wage Rates for this project, available at the Department of Public Works, and are also available at the State of California Division of Labor Statistics and research web site at <http://www.dir.ca.gov/DLSR/PWD/index.htm>.
11. The County of Marin, and its Contractors and/or Subcontractors will not discriminate against any individual based on race, color, religion, nationality, sex, age or disability.
