### **OCTOBER 24 IS DEADLINE TO REGISTER TO VOTE**

Monday, October 24, is the deadline to register to vote in the November 8, 2011 General District Election. To be eligible to register to vote a person must be a US citizen, resident of California, 18 years old by Election Day, not in prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony, and not determined to be mentally incompetent by a judge.

Mail-in voter registration forms are available at post offices, libraries, city clerks' offices, fire stations, and the Department of Motor Vehicles. Voters may also print out and mail a registration form from the Elections website at

[www.marinvotes.org](http://www.marinvotes.org). **Voter registration forms must be postmarked by the**

**October 24th deadline to be valid for the upcoming election.**

The Marin County Election Office is open weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for in-person registration. The office is located at the Marin Civic Center, 3501 Civic Center Drive, Room 121, San Rafael, CA 94903.
