## QUICK GUIDE to Voting in Marin!



### The Voter's Choice Act Comes to Marin! What's New?

---

- ★ All active registered voters are automatically mailed a ballot,
- ★ Early voting is expanded for more days, and
- ★ Voters may vote in-person at any regional Vote Center in Marin

### Your Voter Registration

---



If you need to make changes to your voter registration you may do so online at [RegisterToVote.ca.gov](https://RegisterToVote.ca.gov), or if after May 23, at any Vote Center in Marin.

### Voting Options

---



**You may vote the ballot mailed to you.**

The first day ballots are mailed is **May 9** (allow 5-7 days to arrive).

Insert it into the mailing envelope sent to you, then seal.

Sign the outside of the envelope.



**Need an accessible ballot or translated sample ballot?** Contact the Elections Dept.



**You may vote in-person at any Vote Center to:** ★ Vote early or on Election Day

★ Register and vote the same day ★ Use an accessible voting machine

★ Request help filling out your ballot ★ Replace a lost ballot; or ask for other help

### Return Your Ballot

---



**You have THREE ways to return your ballot: (No stamp needed!)**

★ By mail. It must be postmarked before or on Election Day;

★ Drop your ballot in any Official Ballot Drop Box; OR

★ Take your ballot to any Vote Center.
