RESOLUTION OF THE MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS, the Marin County Board of Supervisors has determined that certain roads, because of their topography, narrow lanes and limited site distances, are unsafe for vehicles in excess of 36'

WHEREAS, the Marin County Board of Supervisors has determined that certain roads constructed many years ago under previous design standards include short vertical and horizontal curves and/or steep grades in close proximity to the curves and are unsafe for vehicles in excess of 36' since the drivers of such vehicles often cross over the centerline of the road; and

WHEREAS, the Marin County Board of Supervisors has further determined that buses, because of the noise they make and their size, are inimical to the tranquility expected on residential streets; and

WHEREAS, the Marin County Board of Supervisors adopted Marin County Code Chapter 13.06 to address these issues.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED pursuant to Marin County Code Section 13.06.10, motor vehicles in excess of thirty-six (36) feet are prohibited from traveling over the following streets and highways:

1. Muir Woods Road.
2. Panoramic Highway.
3. Tennessee Valley Road.
4. Sequoia Valley Road.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED pursuant to Marin County Code Section 13.06.20, tour buses, are prohibited from traveling over the following streets and highways:

1. Montford Avenue.
2. Pacific Way.
3. Ross Drive.
4. Jean Street.
5. Laurel Way.
6. Poplar Street.
7. Pine Street.
8. Spruce Street.
9. Ash Street.
10. Maple Street.
11. Marin Avenue.
12. Edgewood Avenue
13. Flamingo Road.
14. Almonte Blvd.
15. Seacape Drive.
16. Enterprise Concourse.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED pursuant to Marin County Code Section 13.06.40, each violation of any section within Marin County Code 13.06 shall result in a fine of \$100 for a first offence, a fine of \$200 for a second offence by the same person or company within a period of 365 days or less, and a fine of \$500 for a third or subsequent offence by the same person or company within a period of 365 days or less.
