RECOMMENDATIONS: 1) Hold a public hearing to consider a 1.79% rate increase by the Ratto Group of Companies Inc. (Redwood Empire Disposal) for the West Marin Franchise Area No. 1; and 2) approve amended agreement.

SUMMARY: The Ratto Group of Companies, Inc. has the exclusive franchise for refuse and recycling in West Marin for Franchise Area No. 1. This franchise area includes the West Marin coast area with the exception of Bolinas and Stinson Beach.

The franchise agreement with the Ratto Group of Companies, Inc. establishes a rate setting methodology based on a Refuse Rate Index (RRI). The RRI is a price indexing method designed specifically for adjusting waste collection rates based on changes in fuel, labor, and vehicle maintenance and replacement expenses. The agreement calls for an automatic RRI adjustment on January 1 of each year for three years, and a full audit every fourth year. The agreement states that 2015 will be an RRI adjustment year and the established methodology shows that a 0.79% increase is warranted.

To further comply with the County's zero waste goals, a second "bulky item" pickup is being added to the residential service for an additional 1% increase in the rates. In addition, an increased reporting provision for street sweeping is being added to better comply with stormwater protection reporting requirements. The amended agreement documents the two service changes being implemented.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is an estimated increase of approximately \$5,200 in General Fund franchise fees associated with the proposed rate increase. There is no additional impact to the General Fund.
