PROCLAIMING
NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK
MAY 21 – 27, 2017

WHEREAS, sustainable public works infrastructure, services and facilities are vital to Marin County and integral to the safety, health, and general well-being of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is crucial to the efficient operation of public works systems and programs such as roadways, transportation, public buildings, waste management, watershed management, land development and conscious sustainability; and

WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these services and facilities, as well as the planning, design, construction and maintenance, are vitally dependent upon the commitment and skills of Marin County Department of Public Works personnel; and

WHEREAS, the dedication of Marin County Department of Public Works staff is motivated by the importance of their work and sustained by the gratitude expressed by the community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works helps make Marin County a safer and better place to live by maintaining and improving the County's infrastructure, including 52 public service properties, over 420 miles of roadway, eight watersheds with a multitude of waterways; implementing sustainable planning initiatives; providing outstanding emergency response to recent winter storm damage and subsequent long-term repair efforts; and

WHEREAS, this year marks the 57th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association with the intention of promoting appreciation for the role that such departments play in our communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin hereby proclaims the week of May 21 – 27, 2017 as "National Public Works Week" in Marin County.
