Please join me in welcoming the Marin Resource Conservation District (RCD) to present at our March 19th Board of Supervisors meeting. The Marin RCD has been doing remarkable work in our community to conserve and enhance Marin's natural resources, including its soil, water, vegetation and wildlife. The Marin RCD offers a variety of programs to facilitate implementation of conservation projects in Marin County. Additionally, they bring together state, federal and local agencies with private landowners to conserve soil and water resources.

Since 1983, Marin RCD has administered over \$20 million dollars in government and private foundation grants for watershed-wide erosion control, creek restoration, and road repair projects. Marin RCD has been directly involved in carbon sequestration research within our Marin Carbon Project partnership to investigate the carbon sequestration potential of local farming practices. This effort is expected to enable farmers and ranchers achieve carbon neutrality and, in turn, enhance the sustainability of agriculture.

At our upcoming Board of Supervisors meeting they would like to provide us with a general update on their current work in Marin.
