SUMMARY: The CWPP represents more than four years of work by a diverse group of fire professionals, wildfire science experts, and community stakeholders to produce an update to Marin's CWPP, which incorporates new and improved data, lessons learned from recent wildfires, current state-of-the-art hazard and risk analysis, and which broadly addresses wildfire risk and hazard in Marin County and provides a framework for future mitigation efforts.

EQUITY IMPACT: Marin County Fire Department (MCFD), in collaboration with other fire agencies, Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority, Marin County Office of Equity, and community partners, will expand the seasonal workforce to support wildfire prevention efforts while establishing a pathway to sustainable wage careers for traditionally underrepresented, underserved, and underfunded young adults from Marin County. To successfully meet the above goal, the CWPP has identified project work throughout the County.

FISCAL IMPACT: Funding to update the CWPP was provided through a FEMA Hazard Mitigation grant; there is no net county cost for this update or adoption.
