2. Honorary Ranger Badge

- Check out our <u>online calendar</u> and attend a ranger event or naturalist walk.
- Event leads will have stickers at the event.

3. Home Warrior Badge

- Defend your home and create a safe space for you and local wildlife to thrive.
- Plant a native plant or garden, check for bird nests before trimming trees in your yard, or visit <u>FireSafe Marin</u> to learn how to create a fire-safe yard.
- Take a photo of any home improvements and share on Instagram (be sure to tag us @MarinCountyParks) or submit your photo online.

4. Land Explorer Badge

- Visit a Marin County park or open space that you haven't been to before.
- Take a photo and share it on Instagram (be sure to tag us @MarinCountyParks) or submit your photo <u>online</u>.



5. Land Protector Badge
