Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended your Board approve the enclosed First Amendment to Emergency Communications System Maintenance Agreement.

SUMMARY: On March 2, 2004, your Board entered into an Emergency Communications Systems Maintenance Agreement with the Marin Emergency Radio Authority (MERA). This Agreement allows MERA to obtain services from the County DPW-Communications Maintenance Division to install, maintain and repair its electronics/communication equipment.

The enclosed Agreement increases the hourly reimbursement amount for Technicians from \$55.00 to \$70.00 per hour.

FISCAL IMPACT: The revenue increase was anticipated in the proposed Communications Maintenance budget.
