RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF THE MARIN COUNTY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT ASSOCIATION (MCERA) AMENDING THE BYLAWS AND REGULATIONS OF THE MARIN COUNTY EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT ASSOCIATION, SECTION 801

The Bylaws and Regulations of the Marin County Employees' Retirement Association are hereby amended with the new language indicated, as follows:

Section 801, under <u>NOMINATIONS</u>, Paragraph No. 1, to read as follows:

Nomination of the members to be elected from and by members of the Retirement Association shall be by petition signed by not less than ten (10) members of the Association. No person shall sign more than one petition of nomination for each member.

Section 801, under <u>CANDIDATE'S STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS</u>, Paragraph No. 2, to read as follows:

The statement may include the name, age and occupation of the candidate and a brief description, no more than 200 words in length, of the candidate's education and qualifications.
