

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN
DELEGATING THE POWER TO RESTRICT USE OF, OR TEMPORARILY CLOSE
COUNTY HIGHWAYS TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California in Section 942.5 allows the Board of Supervisors to restrict the use of, or temporarily close, any County Highway whenever the Board considers such closing or restriction of use necessary:

- a. For protection of the public.
- b. For the protection of such County Highway from damage during storms.
- c. During construction, improvement or maintenance operations thereon.

WHEREAS, Section 942.6 of the Streets and Highways Code allows the Board of Supervisors to delegate the powers outlined in Section 942.5 to the County Road Commissioner (Director of Public Works), and

WHEREAS, such delegation of power to the Director of Public Works will reduce the time required to process a request for a restriction in use of temporary closure of a County Highway, and

WHEREAS, such delegation of power to the Director of Public Works will cause an increase in efficiency in handling such a request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Director of Public Works is authorized to approve, conditionally approve, or disapprove requests to restrict the use of or to temporarily close a County Highway.
