RESOLUTION OF THE MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CONTINUING THE LOCAL EMERGENCY FOR MARIN COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Assistant Director of Emergency Services found that due to a severe winter storm and flooding, a condition of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property exists in the County of Marin and all its cities, and that these conditions are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of Marin County; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with State law and Marin County code, the Assistant Director of Emergency Services proclaimed the existence of a local emergency throughout said county effective December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the Proclamation of Local Emergency was forwarded through the State Director of the Office of Emergency Service to the Governor of California with the request that he proclaim the County of Marin to be in a state of emergency; and further that the Governor request a Presidential Declaration; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 2006-01 on January 6, 2006, ratifying the Proclamation of a Local Emergency and requesting the Governor and the President of the United States to issue declarations of emergency for the County of Marin; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the current conditions, the Board of Supervisors finds that a condition of emergency still exists in the County of Marin due to flooding, landslides, and property and infrastructure damage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors finds there is a need to continue the local emergency in effect in Marin County, in conformance with the requirements of Government Code Section 8630.
