RESOLUTION OF THE MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS the County of Marin desires to undertake a training project to stop abuse and sexual assault against elder persons and individuals with disabilities, to be funded in part by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Marin County District Attorney to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Violence Against Women, for a grant entitled *Training Grant to Stop Abuse Against Older Individuals or Individuals with Disabilities*. The Board further authorizes the District Attorney to execute on behalf of the County of Marin the Grant Award Agreement for this grant program, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The U.S. Department of Justice disclaims responsibility for any such liability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
