WHEREAS, we are quite certain that John would consider his greatest accomplishment to be his lifelong marriage to childhood sweetheart Connie Coleman Govi, and the loving and wonderful family they created together with sons Richard, Jack and Bob. Known affectionately as "Papa" to his five grandchildren, his indomitable spirit and zest for life will continue to live on forever in the hearts and minds of all who love him, and who he has loved so well.
