RECOMMENDATION:

- 1. Authorize the President to sign the amended FY 2006/07 contract agreements with Center Point in the amount of \$151,796.00 and with Teena Scovis-Weston in the amount of \$52,687.00 for Adult Drug Court services.
- 2. Approve the following budget adjustments:

SUMMARY: The California Drug Court Implementation (CDCI) Program grant that funds part of Marin County's Adult Drug Court program includes stringent admission and reimbursement requirements, including the requirement that the participants be eligible felons. To date, there have not been any Drug Court clients this fiscal year that are eligible for this funding stream. (Note that there have been 18 clients overall in the Drug Court program this fiscal year but none of these required the types of treatment eligible for reimbursement under the CDCI grant.)

In order to make the necessary adjustments to reflect the unavailability of the CDCI funds, the Department proposes the recognition and allocation of \$15,037 in federal Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment (SAPT) Block Grant funds for these services.

COMMUNITY IMPACT: Substance abuse is a serious concern and pervasive problem in Marin County. The contractual agreements provide essential drug treatment services to residents of Marin County who face drug-related criminal charges and who are amenable to recovery and treatment while under the formal supervision of the Superior Court.

FISCAL/STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no net County cost associated with this action.
