**SUMMARY:** Existing Marin County Ordinance No. 2219 (Exhibit A) provides that the two appointed Housing Authority Commissioners must be tenants of the Housing Authority public housing programs. Federal law requires that at least one appointed commissioner of the Housing Authority be directly assisted by the Authority. Directly assisted is defined to mean that the Commissioner must be a public housing resident or a recipient of housing assistance from Marin Housing Authority. The revised ordinance (Exhibit B) will provide that one Commissioner must be a tenant of the Housing Authority, one Commissioner must be directly assisted, and of the two, at least one Commissioner must be aged 62 or older.

The proposed change would broaden the existing ordinance to allow the Board of Supervisors to appoint one Commissioner who is not a tenant of the Housing Authority, but is a recipient of housing assistance through the Section 8 program.
