PROCLAIMING FAIR HOUSING MONTH APRIL, 2007

- WHEREAS, the principle of fair housing is not only national law and national policy but a fundamental human concept and entitlement for all citizens; and
- **WHEREAS,** discrimination based on race, national origin, gender, disability, familial status (exclusion of minor children), religion, marital status, and sexual orientation is illegal in California; and
- **WHEREAS**, as a community we welcome all good neighbors, recognizing the contributions and richness tendered by a wide variety of young and old, male and female, people of all colors and ethnic backgrounds, religious traditions, etc.; and
- **WHEREAS**, during the month of April, interested parties from both the private and public sectors will participate in a national effort to promote fair housing.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin hereby proclaims the month of April 2007, as "Fair Housing Month" and joins in observing the week with appropriate activities.
- **BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED** that the Marin County Board of Supervisors urges all residents of our community to personally adopt the spirit of equal housing opportunity and to adhere to the letter and spirit of Fair Housing Laws.
