Residents will be charged for electricity used <u>in excess</u> of the Allowances specified above as follows:

• KWHs in excess of the Quarterly Allowance **X** the <u>current Pacific Gas & Electric charge for KWHs per the <u>"Tier" 2, Residential E-1</u> (Non-Care) rate schedule.</u>

## For Natural Gas Consumption:

Residents will be charged for natural gas used <u>in excess</u> of the Allowances specified above as follows:

 CCFs in excess of the Quarterly Allowance X the average multiplier for the particular quarter to convert CCFs to Therms X the <u>current Pacific Gas & Electric charge for Therms per the</u> <u>"Excess", Residential G-1</u> (Non-Care) rate schedule.

<sup>\*\* &</sup>quot;KWH" means Kilowatt-Hour (Note: This is a unit of energy.)

<sup>&</sup>quot;CCF" means 100 Cubic Feet (Note: this is a measurement of volume. A variable which indicates how much energy is in a specific volume of gas must be applied to convert a CCF of gas to Therms [a unit of energy])
