Project Description:

The Woodacre Creek at Carson Road Fish Passage Restoration Project restores passage for salmon and steelhead into the upper reaches of Woodacre Creek, a tributary to San Geronimo Creek within the Lagunitas Creek Watershed. The Project will modify approximately 120 linear feet of Woodacre Creek located under Carson Rd., between Redwood Drive and Oak Grove Avenue in Woodacre, CA. and replaces two existing culverts under Carson Road with a new 16' wide steel arched culvert on concrete footings. Work includes but is not limited to dewatering, re-grading the creek bed, installation of the new arched culvert and headwall, placement of two rock structures spanning the creek, fill of bank slope protection and river rock, split-rail fencing, guardrail installation, and final restoration of Carson Road.

The Engineer's Estimate for this project is \$310,000.

Award of contract, if awarded, will be to the lowest responsible bidder whose proposal complies with prescribed requirements, and will be within thirty (30) days after receipt of proposals.

The County of Marin reserves the right to reject any or all bids and the right to waive any irregularities.

The provisions of Public Contract Code 22300, regarding substitution of securities for monies withheld to ensure performance shall apply to this contract.

No prebid meeting is scheduled for this project.

The Contractor shall posses a valid Class "A" License at the time contract is awarded.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code, Section 12990.

The successful bidder shall furnish a payment bond and a performance bond.
