- 1. Approves the filing of an application for grant funds in the amount of \$150,000 from the Partners for Fish and Wildlife Projects Program; and

Appoints the General Manager of the Marin County Open Space District, or her designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations and execute and submit all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and/or any documents that may be necessary for the completion of project(s).
