**SUBJECT: Temporary Closure of Wharf Road and Brighton Avenue,
Bolinas – District 4.**

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the temporary road closure for the time and date specified below.

SUMMARY: The Department of Public Works has received a request from the Briones Lions Club to temporarily close Wharf Road from Brighton Avenue to the beach in Bolinas on Saturday, July 4, 2009, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. for the annual 4th of July celebration. The Lions Club will conduct traffic control for detours, persons seeking parking, and/or alternate temporary closures at the following locations:

1. Terrace Avenue at Overlook
2. Overlook at Mesa
3. Horseshoe Hill Road at Olema Bolinas

FISCAL/STAFFING IMPACT: None.

DISCUSSION: The encroachment permit will be issued including the following conditions:

1. Traffic control shall be provided by the applicant at their expense and approved prior to the event by the California Highway Patrol and Sheriff.
2. Access shall be maintained at all times for emergency vehicles and residents.
3. Signs and barricades shall be placed to denote road closure and redirect traffic.
4. All litter and debris shall be removed immediately upon conclusion of the event.
