REGARDING: Authorization by the Board of Supervisors of projects recommended by the Marin County Fish & Wildlife Commission (MCFWC) for the enhancement of fish and wildlife resources in Marin County for FY 2010-11.

RECOMMENDATION: Funding for \$19,293 of the total amount requested for the recommended projects and administrative support is authorized in the MCFWC FY 2010-11 Proposed Budget, which is being considered by your Board. The remaining \$5,000 is contributed by the DPW MCSTOPPP program and will be invoiced from their FY 2010-11 Proposed Budget. The total recommendation for the projects is \$24,293.

SUMMARY: MCFWC annually reviews grant requests from local organizations to fund projects that promote restoration, sustainable use, management, and related educational programs of the fish and wildlife resources in Marin County. The Commission then provides recommendations to the Board of Supervisors based on their merit and the availability of funds. MCFWC asks that the Board approve these recommended funding requests. These grants, if approved, would be initiated in FY 2010-11.

NOTE: This year, due to reduced state allocations, we are limiting our recommendations for grant disbursements.

FISCAL IMPACT: There are no General Fund costs associated with this request.
