**RESOLUTION OF THE MARIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**  
**SUPPORTING PROPOSITION 21**  
**THE STATE PARKS AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION TRUST FUND**

**WHEREAS**, California's parks have been threatened by chronic underfunding. Nearly 150 state parks were shuttered part-time or suffered deep service reductions, and more park closure proposals and budgetary reductions are anticipated in the year ahead; and

**WHEREAS**, Proposition 21 – "The State Parks and Wildlife Conservation Trust Fund" - would provide a stable, reliable, and adequate funding source for the state park system, for wildlife conservation, and for increased and equitable access to those resources for all Californians; and

**WHEREAS**, funding for the Trust Fund would come from an \$18 annual State Park Access charge imposed on all California vehicles registered annually with the State; and

**WHEREAS**, California vehicles subject to the State Park Access Pass surcharge and all occupants of those vehicles would receive free day use admission to all state parks; and

**WHEREAS**, every year, there are nearly 80 million visits to state parks, where the abundance of outdoor activities entices visitors to exercise and lead healthier lifestyles; and

**WHEREAS**, parks contribute to public health by protecting forests and natural areas that are sources of clean air and water and by combating climate change by reducing greenhouse gases.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** the County of Marin supports Proposition 21 - the "State Parks and Wildlife Conservation Trust Fund Act of 2010," on the November, 2010 statewide ballot.
