SUBJECT: Juvenile Accountability Block Grant - Resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to submit Marin County's Reapplication for continuation of FY 2010-2011 funding.

Dear Board Members:

RECOMMENDATION: Request from the Probation Department to adopt resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to submit Marin County's reapplication to the State Corrections Standards Authority for \$17,940 in Juvenile Accountability Block Grants funds to support the Marin County Juvenile Drug Court.

SUMMARY: The Probation Department is requesting that the Board authorize the Chief Probation Officer to reapply for Federal funds under the above referenced program. For several years these funds have helped support our Juvenile Drug Court. Specifically, Marin County will receive a block grant in the amount of \$17,940.

The Juvenile Drug Court is a judge-centered, collaborative and intensive program that provides supervision to some of the most challenging youth on probation. The program is an integral component in dealing with substance abuse issues and helping to reduce recidivism.

FISCAL IMPACT: We are applying for a total of \$17,940 in Federal funds to support our Juvenile Drug Court. The Juvenile Accountability Block Grant requires a 10% county cash match of \$1,794. Marin County has consistently supported the Juvenile Drug Court beyond the 10% county cash match. These funds are included in the proposed budget for FY 2010/2011.
