## 1. <u>THOMSEN COASTAL PERMIT AND USE PERMIT (Project I.D. P1248) AND</u> <u>CEQA EXEMPTION (14-25) The project is located at 125 Buena Vista Avenue,</u> <u>Stinson Beach, further identified as Assessor's Parcel 195-191-32.</u>
