On March 8, 2017, the California Coastal Commission approved the County's request for a one year time extension (to May 2, 2018) for Marin County's Local Coastal Program Amendment Number LCP - 2-MAR-15-0029-1. The purpose of the time extension is to acknowledge and accept the modifications suggested by the California Coastal Commission on LCP Amendment No. LCP-2-MAR-15-0029-1 (Marin LCP Update) at the Commission hearing on November 2, 2016. The Commission's action is not final and effective until the Marin County Board of Supervisors accepts and agrees to the Commission's certification of those amendments with suggested modifications. If the Board has not accepted and agreed to the suggested modifications by that time, then the Commission's certification with suggested modifications expires. The Coastal Commission also continued the hearing on the portion of the LCP Update relating to Environmental Hazards. Unless withdrawn by Marin County, the deadline for the Commission to act on the environmental hazards portion of the Marin LCP Update is September 29, 2017.
