Active Ingredient: Balsam fir oil

Amount of material needed: 24 pouches

Location of Proposed Use: Marin County fleet vehicle garage, Civic Center

Reason why Restricted: This product is not on the County's allowed products list;

Reason for Need: This is a potential replacement for EVAC, which has been discontinued, to repel rodents from nesting and chewing on electrical wires and insulation in the vehicle engine compartment.


Options/Alternatives: Previous balsam fir oil product (EVAC) no longer manufactured; trapping is not feasible, adjacent vegetation is mowed.

Plan to Preclude Future Use: Improve sanitation and exclusion, weed management. This is a safe, organic product that is an effective repellent.
